Applications are accepted after the BSA releases the information video on 8 January and all conditions for application are met and the Transatlantic Council Executive Board chooses to participate in this program at its meeting on January 20th. Packs will be informed on January 22nd if they have been chosen to participate.

Pack _____ applies to participate in the Family Scouting Early Adopter program and agrees to the following:

1. The Chartered Organization agrees to participate in the Family Scouting Early Adopter program as signed by the Institutional Head or the Chartered Organization Representative below.
2. The pack must have completed all of the recharter paperwork and have paid all fees including the Overseas Council Fee
3. Our pack agrees to register a minimum of **four** girls into a **new all-girl den** in our pack. (Dens will be in the same grade or required ages for the rank of Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear, and first-year Webelos). Dens will not be mixed or combined (no mixed Lion/Tiger Wolf/Bear etc.).
4. Our pack agrees that all girls will be registered by March 15, 2018 and understand no applications will be accepted after that date.
5. Our pack agrees that all participants will accomplish rank requirements by May 31, 2018 and If approved our pack will submit our advancement plan so that rank badges will be earned by May 31st.
6. Our pack understands that only the current Cub Scouting program and resources are available
7. Our pack will uphold membership policies
8. Our pack will participate in feedback and surveys concerning their experiences to assist in formal program roll-out
9. Our pack will ensure that leaders are trained (Youth Protection and Leader specific training)
10. Our pack agrees to have a Friends of Scouting presentation to support Transatlantic Council fund-raising efforts and to offset the costs of operating a BSA council overseas.
