- 1. An individual or unit submits the new proposed Historic Trail, along with patch design, to the district executive in their area. Current staff listing is at Staff Contacts Transatlantic Council (tac-bsa.org) This will include funding of \$400 to place an order for an initial stock of 200 Historic Trail patches—at this secure online payment portal: https://donations.scouting.org/#/council/802/appeal/5792
- 2. The district executive then sends the proposal, along with thoughts and recommendations, to the TAC International Representative, who is currently Joshua Dick senatorjsd@aol.com
- 3. The TAC International Representative then sends the proposal to the TAC International Committee member responsible for Historic Trails.
- 4. This individual reviews the proposal and makes recommendations for approval, rejection, or changes and circulates the whole package to the TAC International Committee for approval. 430-240(15) WEB.pdf (scouting.org)
- 5. Once the TAC International Committee has approved the proposal (along with any requested changes), the proposal is final and will be communicated to the TAC Executive Board or TAC Executive Committee (sent to the Scout Executive for handling) for their awareness.
- 6. The TAC International Committee will be responsible for uploading the Historic Trail on TAC's website as well as promoting it via social media and other areas where International Scouting is highlighted. <u>Historic Trails Transatlantic Council (tac-bsa.org)</u>
- 7. TAC will also work with BSA to get the Historic Trail officially approved by them so that it can appear on the official listing of BSA's Historic Trails.
