Implementing the Action Plan

- 74 Action Items in the 6 Action Areas
- District and unit partners supporting planet friendly parts of program
- Support units in sustainability projects, recycling drives, uniform swaps & tree-planting
- Work with Camp Directors on running camps sustainably
- Discuss travel with staff & board
- Work with suppliers on purchasing
- Work with others in the BSA to promote Conservation & Sustainability





Mission Status Highlights

- In October 2024, surpassed our initial goal of planting 4000 trees (or equivalents) by end-2025! Recommending new goal of 5000.
- Conservation projects in Germany, Spain, Dubai, England, Abu Dhabi
- 156 Sustainability and Environmental Science MBs awarded in 2023
- Class B using recycled plastic backing for all patches because of TAC!
- Advocacy with other councils at two BSA National Annual Meetings
- Sustainability policies implemented at council camps; improvements planned. Meal based emissions reduced
- Carbon neutral for 2 years only council in the BSA
- Journey to Sustainability, Sustainability Coordinator unit position, and Sustainability Challenge fine tuned
- Continued focus on quantifying impacts & emissions



Our Current Focus

- Unit activity: Journey to Sustainability;
 Sustainability Coordinators; Sustainability
 Challenge
- District engagement: in district activities, and unit support (see Action Items in Action Plan for ideas)
- Interacting with more units
- Constant improvements in sustainable camping, and in maximizing program impact
- Training
