| Training | Program | Frequency | How | Why/Notes | Recommendations/Best Practice |

| Position Specific | All | Technically, once | Self-paced at my.scouting.org training, in person or virtual instructor led by district or council | No one wants to start a job without some sort of onboarding process, Scouting is no exception! Requirement to be able to wear the trained leader patch | Recommend doing annually with all leaders serving in that role, regardless of experience to keep up with program changes and their impact and to establish a common base level of KSAs for the Unit leadership. |
| Youth Protection | All | Biennial | Self-paced at my.scouting.org training, in person or virtual instructor led by district or council | Understand and apply Scouting America's barriers to abuse policies Requirement to be able to wear the trained leader patch | Recommend doing annually with all leaders serving in that role, regardless of experience to keep up with program changes and their impact and to establish a common base level of KSAs for the Unit leadership. |
| Hazardous Weather | All | Annually | Self-paced at my.scouting.org training, in person or virtual instructor led by district or council | Understand weather impacts on Scouting Activities | Recommended annually as part of the annual planning process |
| Safe Swim | All | Biennial | Self-paced at my.scouting.org training | Understand best practices for Scouters and Scouts in and around the water during Scouting Activities | Recommend doing as part of planning any water activities to keep safety practices fresh |
| BALOO Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation | Cub Leaders | Technically, once | Part 1 online Part 2 in person over a weekend by the District Training Team | Teaches leaders how to plan overnight activities and appropriately apply and teach outdoor skills in a Cub Scout setting | Not required to wear the trained leader patch, but is required for any overnight and outdoor activities At least one trained leader at all overnight events – to include AOL activities with a Troop |
| IOLS Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills | Troop Leaders | Technically, once | In person over a weekend by the District Training Team | Teaches leaders how to appropriately apply and teach outdoor skills in a Troop setting | Required for SM & ASM to wear trained patch |

| National Camp School – Short Term Camp | Any | Every 3 years | Council led training under authorization from NCS | Any event with three overnights or less involving Scouts/ers from two or more units is required to be managed by a Scouter with Short Term Camp Administration Training, planned and approved by the district. | When in doubt, ask your Unit Commissioner or district leadership for guidance. |
| National Camp School – Day Camp Administration | Cubs | Every 5 years | Council led training under authorization from NCS | Any Cub Scout event 1-5 days where cubs arrive and leave each day and involves Scouts/ers from two or more units is required to be managed by a Scouter with Short Term Camp Administration Training, planned and approved by the district. | When in doubt, ask your Unit Commissioner or district leadership for guidance. |
| Wood Badge | All | Once | Council led training | Teaches best practice leadership skills in the Scout setting | Set a Unit goal to send at least one adult leader each year to Wood Badge to provide maximum benefit to your unit program. |
